Mr President,

I have the honour to formally inform you that the Government of the Republic of San Marino officially recognised the State of Palestine on 23 September 2025.

The Government of San Marino has received a clear, unequivocal and unanimous mandate from its Parliament to recognise the State of Palestine, and this mandate is based on San Marino's century-old traditions of peace and respect for international law.

In light of the principles enshrined in the United Nations Charter, in particular those relating to the self-determination of peoples, the sovereignty of States and the peaceful settlement of international disputes, which are also enshrined in San Marino's Constitution, I had the great privilege of publicly confirming San Marino's recognition of the State of Palestine during the 80th General Assembly of the United Nations on 27 September.

Mr President, in addition to enclosing the text of the decision adopted by the Government of San Marino on 23 September, I am honoured to formally propose to you the establishment of diplomatic relations between our States. A letter from you containing a positive response to this proposal from San Marino shall, together with this letter, constitute an agreement which, for San Marino, shall enter into force upon ratification by Parliament.

While looking forward to receiving your kind reply, which will confirm and formalise our mutual desire to establish diplomatic relations between our countries, I avail myself of this opportunity, Mr President, to renew to you the assurances of my highest consideration.
